 - If you require more than 25 replacement tags per day, you will be required to purchase a full set of tags at \$145.
 - Replacement tags will be couriered to you overnight at your own expense (\$19), or can be picked up at Spartan Industrial Marine during business hours: Monday-Friday from 7am-5pm.

By signing this form, you agree that you want Cape Breton Fish Harvesters Association as your 2017 trap tag supplier and that you agree to purchase **one set of original** trap tags and **any replacement tags** from CBFHA and no other supplier.

One (1) original set of trap tags will be ordered for each fish harvester containing his/her license number, the fishing area and sequential numbers for the trap limit. All costs and fees must be paid to the CBFHA before any tags are issued. If there are any mistakes on your tags you must inform the CBFHA as soon as possible. CBFHA will not be held liable for any incorrect information provided to the association by the license holder/operator or DFO.

Replacement tags will be issued on an “as needed” basis; one for one for 1 – 25 lost tags and Full replacement set for 26 or more lost tags. License holders must complete a “Replacement Tag Request” form and must provide all of the invalid tag numbers, the reason for the replacement tag(s), and the amount of replacement tags requested. The CBFHA will issue your replacement tags within 2 business days of receipt of a written request. Whenever replacement tags are issued, the invalid (lost) tag numbers as well as the valid (replacement) tag numbers will be sent to the local C & P as well as DFO Maritimes Region offices.

All records and documentation of License Holders/Operators will be provided to the CBFHA for the purpose of ordering and administering trap tags. All records and documentation will be made accessible to DFO at any time, and DFO may use these records for court, program audit or other purposes.
